

Intensive animal production

Land used for animal production where the animals' food is imported from outside the immediate building, enclosure, paddock or pen.

Intensive animal production does not include:

- an abattoir or sale yard; or
- grazing animal production, pig farm, poultry farm or poultry hatchery.

Permit required

No meaningful grazing = intensive animal production

* if specified conditions are not met the use becomes a permit required use or a prohibited use.

Land use terms nested under Intensive animal production are:

Intensive dairy farm

Land used for intensive animal production where cattle are kept or bred for the production of milk.

Cattle feedlot

Has the same meaning as the *Victorian Code for Cattle Feedlots 1995*

All Intensive animal production properties require a Property Identification Code (PIC)
