

Statutory Declaration

Statutory Declaration

The person making the declaration is <u>required to read</u> the following paragraph aloud in the presence of the authorised statutory declaration witness (unless that person has a disability which prevents the person from doing so):

"I, [full name of person making declaration] of [address], declare that the contents of this statutory declaration are true and correct."
