Stop, Think, Choose wisely

LOW IMPORTANCE

- Amoxicillin
- Chlortetracycline (non-lactating)
- Erythromycin
- Florfenicol
- Oxytetracycline
- Penethamate
- Penicillin
- Neomycin
- Tilmicosin
- Tylosin
- Tulathromycin

MEDIUM IMPORTANCE

- Apramycin
- Trimethoprim sulphonamides

HIGH IMPORTANCE

- Ceftiofur #
- Virginiamycin †

† If no alternative, **PREVENTION FIRST**, treatment as last resort.

Use only in an individual animal in exceptional circumstances, after culture and sensitivity testing, if there is no alternative; do not use for mastitis.

PROHIBITED

- Fluoroquinolones
- Gentamicin
- Chloramphenicol
- Metronidazole
- Nitrofurans
- Injectable streptomycin
- Colistin

NB: Only those products registered for use in cattle are included. Products only registered for intramammary or topical use are not included.
