

SAMPLE NEWSPAPER NOTICE

for a

HORSE AGISTMENT LIEN

under the

Impounding of Livestock Act 1994

Note: the following text **MUST** appear in the newspaper Notice for the creation of a lien.

<p>Attention:</p> <p>(name of horse owner).</p> <p>Agistment fees are owed for the horse left at</p> <p>.....</p> <p>(general location of the property at which the horse is being agisted) by you.</p> <p>Part 3A of the Impounding of Livestock Act 1994 now applies.</p> <p>For details contact</p> <p>(contact details of person issuing the default notice).</p>

The Notice must be published in the "public notices" section of a daily newspaper that circulates generally in Victoria.

If contacted by the horse owner after this Notice is published in the newspaper, the landowner then provides the horse owner with a Default Notice (See 'Sample Default Notice' for details).

If a Notice is published in a newspaper in accordance with the Act, the default notice is taken to be served on the day the newspaper containing the notice is published.
