

H5 bird flu: how you can help

H5 bird flu has been confirmed in Victoria. If you see sick or dead birds or other wildlife, do not touch them:

- **AVOID** direct contact
- **RECORD** what you see
- **REPORT** to the hotline or online.

H5 bird flu has been confirmed in Victoria. You can help by watching for signs of bird flu and reporting what you see.

H5 bird flu is a viral disease of birds found around the world. It can cause disease and death in poultry, wild birds and other wildlife.

Report 5 or more groups of sick or dead wild birds of any species, anywhere in Victoria.

Report **even one** sick or dead:

- wild seabird, waterbird, shorebird or bird of prey (e.g. eagles, hawks)
- marine mammal (e.g. seal, sea lion, dolphin).

Reports will be assessed and testing undertaken if needed.
